Tivan to host Community Information Forums for Speewah

The Board of Tivan Limited (ASX: TVN) (“Tivan” or the “Company”) is pleased to advise that the Company will be hosting Community Information Forums in Wyndham and Kununurra in August 2026, as the Speewah Fluorite Project (“Project”) progresses toward completion of its Definitive Feasibility Study (“DFS”) and a Final Investment Decision, targeted for Q4 2026.

The Project has continued to progress in its development, with extensive technical, environmental and social studies now substantially advanced. With a greater body of information available, Tivan considers this an appropriate time to provide a comprehensive project update, discuss the work completed to date, outline the path ahead and hear directly from community members. Tivan continues to work closely with Traditional Owners and Native Title Holders, State and Federal governments, regulators and the broader community as it advances the Project.

The Community Information Forums build upon a briefing that Tivan provided to the Shire of Wyndham-East Kimberley Council (SWEK) earlier this week. The Forums are open to all interested members of the public and will provide an opportunity to:

- hear an update on the Project and its progress toward DFS;
- learn more about the technical, environmental and approvals work undertaken to date, and work upcoming;
- ask questions directly of the project team; and
- share feedback, perspectives and matters of local interest.

Community members are encouraged to RSVP and submit questions ahead of time via engagement@tivan.com.au. Questions and discussion will also be welcomed during the Forums.

The Wyndham Forum will be held on Thursday, 13 August at 4pm and the Kununurra Forum will be held on Friday, 14 August at 4pm. Venues are currently being arranged by Tivan, in coordination with SWEK Council and the East Kimberley Chamber of Commerce & Industry. Recognising that some community members may prefer smaller or one-on-one conversations, Tivan will also host an Open Office Day on Saturday, 15 August 2026 at its Kununurra office at 108A Coolibah Drive, Kununurra.
