

Treatment of Fairfax Media Limited Demerger within the S&P/ASX 200 Index

SYDNEY, NOVEMBER 7, 2017: S&P Dow Jones Indices announced today that it will make the following changes in the S&P/ASX 200 Index, as a result of shareholder and final court approval of the scheme of arrangement under which Fairfax Media Limited (ASX: FXJ) will spin-off Domain Holdings Australia Pty Ltd (ASX: DHA).

Fairfax Media Limited will spin-off 1 share of Domain Holdings Australia Pty Ltd for every 10 Fairfax Media Limited shares held. Domain Holdings Australia Pty Ltd will be added to the S&P/ASX 200 Index effective at the open of trading on November 16, 2017 at a zero price.

There will be no removal from the S&P/ASX 200 Index as a result of the inclusion of Domain Holdings Australia Pty Ltd.
